Key challenges

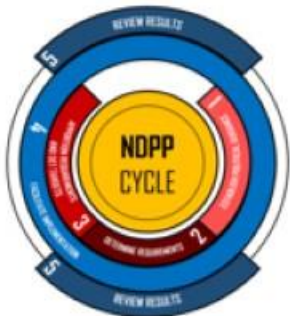
Resource shortages, the need for modernization, weak integration with NATO and complex logistics are hampering defence capabilities.

Branches of Armed Forces

The Land Forces, Air Force and Navy form the basis of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.



Separate branches of troops (forces)

Separate branches of the military include the Air Assault Forces, Special Operations Forces, Unmanned and Medical Forces, Logistics Forces and Support Forces.



New branches of troops (forces)

Assault Forces, Space Forces, Cyber Forces provide support to the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

Other military bodies, military units and institutions

Key priorities

Integrated air defense/missile defense systems

The development of modern air defense/missile defense systems compatible with NATO provides effective protection against air and missile threats.

Unmanned and robotic complexes

Unmanned systems and robotic systems increase combat effectiveness and allow you to perform tasks with minimal risk to people.

High-precision and long-range artillery

Operational-tactical missile systems and high-precision artillery ensure the accuracy of hitting targets at a considerable distance.

Electronic warfare equipment

Electronic warfare systems neutralize threats and strengthen the protection of the information space.

Impact of armed aggression

Resource constraints and international support

Limited resources and slow international support may delay the implementation of key measures.

Imperfection of the legal framework and combat capability

An incomplete legal framework and the risk of loss of combat capability during demobilization affect the effectiveness of the transition.

Management and corruption risks

Management deficiencies and corruption remain significant threats to a successful transition.

Contact groups and coalitions

International assistance through contact groups and capabilities coalitions strengthens Ukraine's defense and cooperation with other countries.

Training and funding

Support in training and financing contributes to the modernization of the defense industry and the development of innovative technologies in Ukraine.

Integration into European security

Cooperation contributes to the integration of Ukraine into the European security system and increases the country's defense capability.
